

2 more resignations from the Woodlake administration

This week, 2 more members of the Woodlake Property Owners Association administration submitted formal letters of resignation. These follow the resignations of the president of the Association, the vice president of the Association and the resignation of a board of directors (BOD) member several weeks ago.

The chairman of the Woodlake Architectural Control Committee (ACC) who has served the Association for the past 12 years, resigned after citing recent BOD failures to follow established *“rules, protocol and process.”* Additionally, the *“Compliance POC”* for the Association who was appointed by the BOD to gain compliance for Association rules and deed restrictions, resigned after reporting he *“had hoped to implement a far less aggressive process to compliance (sic)”* He bestowed his responsibilities on the new secretary of the Association who, along with the other 2 more junior BOD members, has been the impetus for several major changes since the last BOD election in March of this year.
