

Update: Continued divergence within the Woodlake Board of Directors

A few weeks ago, we reported friction within the Woodlake Property Owners Association Board of Directors (see report [here](#)). In Particular, we reported that the 2 senior members of the board had nominated Connie Stokes (Piping Rock Road) to represent Woodlake Section One on the WPOA board of directors but the 3 junior members of the board blocked Stokes' acceptance by refusing to vote.

Although the 3 junior board members could not bring themselves to vote on Ms. Stokes' nomination for weeks, they managed to scurry around and find another candidate for the position and vote him onto the board with no prior announcement to property owners and with no endorsing votes from the senior board members. When asked for the qualifications of the newly found candidate to compare with Stokes' qualifications, the answer from the junior members was simply "*property owner, willing to serve*".

What is the board's explanation for refusing the selection of a supremely qualified representative for Woodlake Section One and instead selecting one with only the basic requirement (property owner)? None yet.

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
